# <u>Clothing Reminders for all Pre-School thru 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students and Parents:</u> • Monday, April 7<sup>th</sup> is the beginning of the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter. <u>Students are welcome to wear shorts</u> to school.

- Temperatures can still be cool in the spring. Please make sure your child has warm clothing for those occasional cool days.
- <u>Please refer to the following K-8<sup>th</sup> Dress Code highlights for this time of year</u>: 

   School clothing should be neat, clean and in good taste. This prohibits styles that are too short, tight, or baggy. <u>Tops should be long enough to avoid a midriff and should cover the entire shoulder. This means tank tops and sleeveless shirts are not allowed!</u> Clothes should not have questionable slogans and/or sayings.
  - Students in grades K-8 may wear shorts to school during the first and last quarter of each year. If you question the weather, send appropriate clothes along to school, as students will not be allowed to call home for a change.
  - Students in grades 5-8 are not allowed to wear leggings as their primary outerwear.
    Shirts/sweaters worn over leggings must be at least mid-thigh in length, same as shorts and skirts.
